Free Speech or Free Beer?

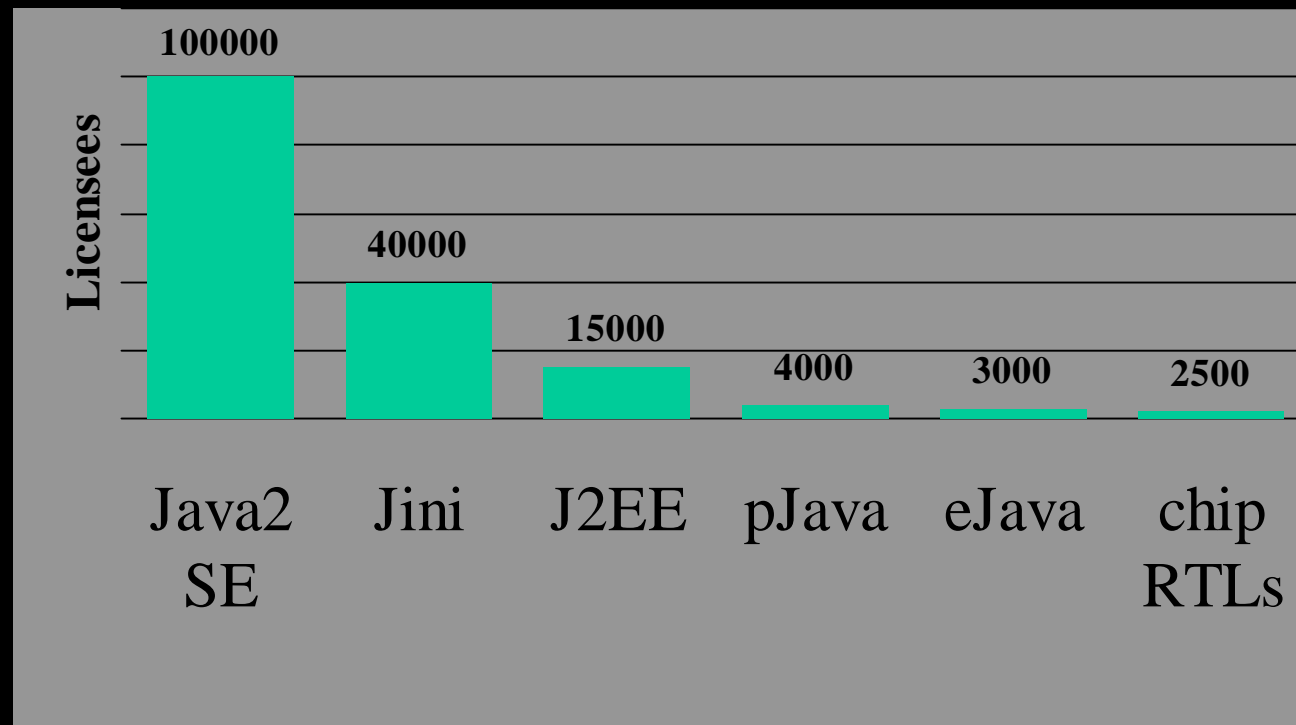
- ∇ Proprietary development is like "secret sauce"

Overview of Sun Technology Source Licensing Programs

- ∇ Free Solaris Source License
 - Targeted at Solaris licensees who need to see sources
- ∇ Sun Community Source License
 - Community Stewardship
- ∇ Sun Industry Standards Source License
 - Technology evolves through a Standards Body
- ∇ Strategic Public Licensing
 - JSP to Apache
 - NFSv4 to UMich

- ▽ 4x Performance Enhancement in Java
- ▽ over 100 bug fixes



Sun's position on Open Source

- ∇ Aligns nicely with our history on Open Standards
- ∇ Grows the overall size of the market

∇ Business Model changes

- Revenue shift
- Can't "corner" the market
- Enhance support offerings
- Map out value adds
- Look at details

Management Challenges in the Open Source world..

∇ Cultural changes

- Senior managers may have to learn new reflexes
- Selecting a license is not a trivial exercise
- End of "Not Invented Here"
- "Right to Fork" not negotiable
- Treat it like a merger

Management Challenges in the Open Source world

- ∇ Engineering changes
 - Different toolsets & procedures
 - Check-in procedures for 3rd party code
 - Modularize
 - Be careful with comments
 - Learn to **trade respect**
 - Learn to herd cats
